A RESOLUTION OF EDGMONT TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ACKNOWLEDGING THE SUBMISSION OF AN OFFICIAL ACT 537 SEWERAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE FOR NEWTOWN TOWNSHIP FOR CDCA MEMBERSHIP, DATED APRIL 27, 2010.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (**Department**) adopted thereunder, chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires a municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of a municipality; and







DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,**


WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires a municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of a municipality, and

WHEREAS, Newtown Township has prepared an "Official Act 537 (PA Sewage Facilities Act) Sewerage Facilities Plan Update for Newtown Township", dated April 27, 2010, which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of Newtown Township,
