ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 130 ENTITLED "SEWERS" OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWTOWN, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BY AMENDING ARTICLE I, SECTION 130-3, GENERAL REGULATIONS WHICH WOULD REQUIRE CONNECTION TO A CONSTRUCTED SANITARY SEWER OR SEWER LATERAL BY VOLUNTARY REQUEST BY HOMEOWNER OR AFTER OFFICIAL NOTICE FROM THE TOWNSHIP TO DO SO WHICH NOTICE SHALL RESULT FROM AN INSPECTION BY A TOWNSHIP REPRESENTATIVE.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Newtown, Delaware County, Pennsylvania hereby ENACT and ORDAIN that:

Section 1. The Newtown Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 130 - Sewers - Section 130 - 3 - General Regulations is hereby amended to read as the following:

"130-3 - General Regulations -

A. Each owner of any occupiable building in the Township on property on which a sewer lateral exists or abutting any sewer lateral or abutting on any public or un-dedicated road, private road, alley, or right-of-way in which there has been constructed a sanitary sewer or sewer lateral or where any part of such building is within 150 ft. of such sewer or sewer lateral may, at his own expense, install suitable sanitary facilities therein, connect such facilities with such sewer and thereafter use such sewer system in accordance with the provisions of this Article. Such connection shall be made within sixty (60) days after date of official notice to do so, but may be made voluntarily prior to receipt of such notice. This official notice shall result from an inspection by a Township representative which would indicate that the homeowners' on-lot disposal system is malfunctioning according to DEP Regulations. In either case, each owner shall make written application to the Township on application forms described by the Township Engineer, for a permit to make the connection and, if entitled to such permit, first pay the charges and fees required by Section C hereof."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the

provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
